The outpouring of tributes from across Africa and the world stands as a testament to his stature as a global leader and a true son of Africa.

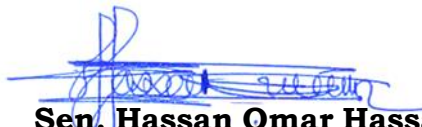
